

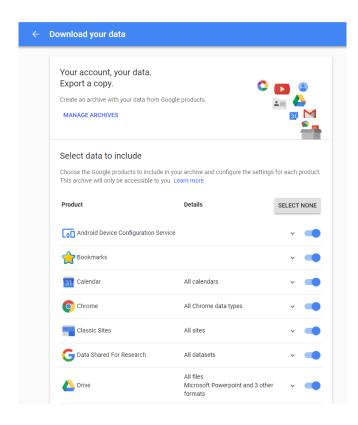
Download data from Griffith Google account

You can create an archive of your Griffith Google account. This allows you to download your data from the Google products you use, such as email, calendar, bookmarks and drive. In a few easy steps, create an archive to keep for your records or use the data in another service.

Depending on the amount of data, creating an archive usually completes within several hours. However, for larger amounts of data this may take up to 24 hours.

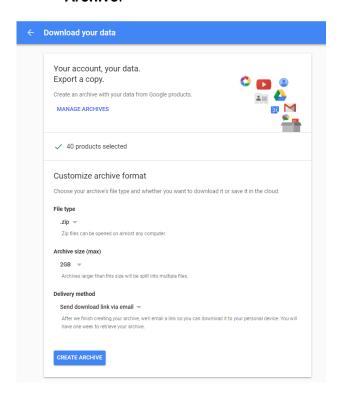

- 1. On your browser, go to: https://takeout.google.com/settings/takeout?pli=1
- 2. Login in with your Griffith account: name@griffithuni.edu.au
- 3. Select the Google components you want to download. Then go all the way to the bottom of the page and click **Next**.

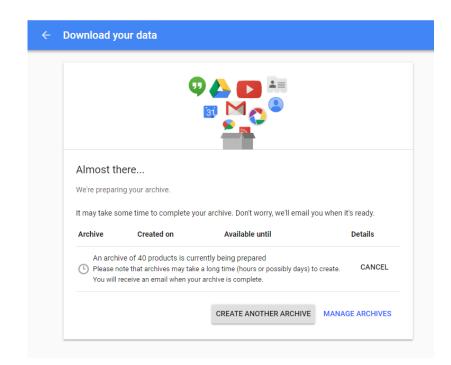




4. Choose your archive's **File type**, **Archive size** and **Delivery method**. Then click **Create Archive**.

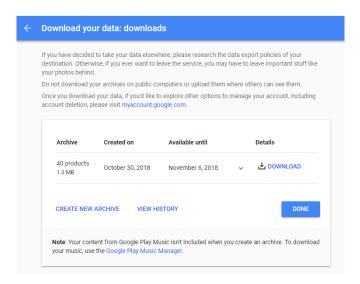


5. Wait for your archive to be created.





6. When your archive is created by using one of these options, you will be emailed a link to its location. Depending on the amount of information in your account, this process could take a few minutes or several hours. Alternatively, you can download your archive from Take Out until the Available until date expires.
