GUPSA BOARD POSITION DESCRIPTIONS:

Chairperson

- 1. The Chairperson is elected by the Board at the first meeting of its term in office.
- 2. The Chairperson shall:
 - a. Speaks on behalf of the Association, Board and the broader Griffith postgraduate community where appropriate;
 - b. Take a leadership role in conjunction with the Board in promoting the Association, its aims, services, and programs where appropriate and endorsed by the Board;
 - c. Act in, or nominate another to act in, the postgraduate representative positions in the University's governance structures that belong to the Chairperson of GUPSA;
 - d. Chair the Board of the Association;
 - e. Provide an Annual Report to the Annual General Meeting;
 - f. Prioritise and delegate tasks and responsibilities as necessary amongst the Board;
 - g. Facilitate discussion within and beyond the Board to develop Association policies and services and achieve Association goals;
 - Maintain and facilitate communication between elements of Griffith University and relevant postgraduate student communities on matters of concern to them;
 - i. Act as a full member of the Board; and
 - j. Carry out such other duties as the Constitution or By-Laws and Board may prescribe or permit.

Coursework Officer

- 1. The Coursework Officer must be a currently enrolled postgraduate Coursework student at Griffith University based on any of the Brisbane or Logan campuses.
- 2. The Coursework Officer is the bridge between the Coursework postgraduate student community, the broader University community, and the Association.
- 3. The Coursework Officer shall:
 - a. Respond to inquiries from, speak for and represent the interests of the Griffith postgraduate coursework student community;
 - b. Prepare and broadcast information for postgraduate coursework students on common areas of concern;

- c. Act as an advisor and champion for grievances raised with the Association by postgraduate coursework students in accordance with the Constitution or By-Laws;
- d. Act as a full member of the Board; and
- e. Carry out such other duties as the Constitution or By-Laws and Board may prescribe or permit.

Research Officer

- The Research Officer must be a currently enrolled postgraduate Research student at Griffith University based on any of the Brisbane or Logan campuses.
- 2. The Research Officer is the bridge between the Research postgraduate student community, the broader University community, and the Association.
- 3. The Research Officer shall:
 - a. Respond to inquiries from, speak for and represent the interests of the Griffith research higher degree student community;
 - b. Prepare and broadcast information for research higher degree students on common areas of concern;
 - c. Act as an advisor and champion for grievances raised with the Association by research higher degree students in accordance with the Constitution or By-Laws;
 - d. Act as a full member of the Board; and
 - e. Carry out such other duties as the Constitution or By-Laws and Board may prescribe or permit.

International Students Officer

- 1. The International Students Officer must be a currently enrolled postgraduate International student at Griffith University based on any of the Brisbane or Logan campuses.
- 2. The International Students Officer is the bridge between the international postgraduate student community, the broader University community, and the Association.
- 3. The International Students Officer shall:
 - a. Broaden awareness in the international postgraduate student community of the role and objectives of the Association and the services it provides;
 - b. Represent the interests of the international postgraduate student community at an Association and a University level;

- c. Liaise with the Campus Coordination Officer to determine the situation of and address the issues facing the international postgraduate student community of each campus;
- d. Liaise with the Griffith University International Students Association and external bodies relevant to international students at Griffith;
- e. Determine specific issues affecting international postgraduate students and make recommendations to the Board and representations to other bodies in the broader University community to address them;
- f. Liaise with the Griffith International Centre on behalf of international student members of the Association;
- g. Act as a full member of the Board; and
- h. Carry out such other duties as the Constitution or By-Laws and Board may prescribe or permit.

Equity Officer

- 1. The Equity Officer must be a currently enrolled postgraduate student from any of the equity groups at Griffith University and based on any of the Brisbane or Logan campuses.
- 2. The Equity Officer is the bridge between all equity groups including but not limited to women, Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander students, queer students or students with a disability the broader University community, and the Association.
- 3. The Equity Officer shall:
 - a. Have an understanding of the majority of Equity groups on all Brisbane and Logan campuses.
 - Broaden awareness in the Equity postgraduate student community of the role and objectives of the Association and the services it provides;
 - c. Represent the interests of the Equity postgraduate student communities at a University level;
 - d. Liaise with the Campus Coordinators to determine the situation of and address the issues facing each campuses' Equity postgraduate student communities;
 - e. Determine specific issues affecting Equity postgraduate students and make recommendations to the Board and representations to other bodies in the broader University community to address them;
 - f. Act as a full member of the Board; and

g. Carry out such other duties as the Constitution or By-Laws and Board may prescribe or permit.

Campus Coordination Officer

- 1. The Campus Coordination Officer must be a currently enrolled postgraduate student at Griffith University based on any of the Brisbane or Logan campuses.
- 2. The Campus Coordinator is the bridge between the local postgraduate community of their campus of the University, the broader University community, and the Association.
- 3. The Campus Coordination Officer shall:
 - a. Broaden awareness in the campus postgraduate student communities of the role and objectives of the Association and the services it provides;
 - b. Respond to inquiries from, speak for and represent the interests of a campus postgraduate student community;
 - c. Coordinate the provision of campus based Association facilities, services, and programs to the postgraduate students of the campuses;
 - d. Determine specific campus issues affecting postgraduate students on their particular campuses and make recommendations to the Board and representations to other bodies in the broader University community to address them;
 - e. Act as a full member of the Board; and
 - f. Carry out such other duties as the Constitution or By-Laws and Board may prescribe or permit.
