Important notes for hiring a visualiser

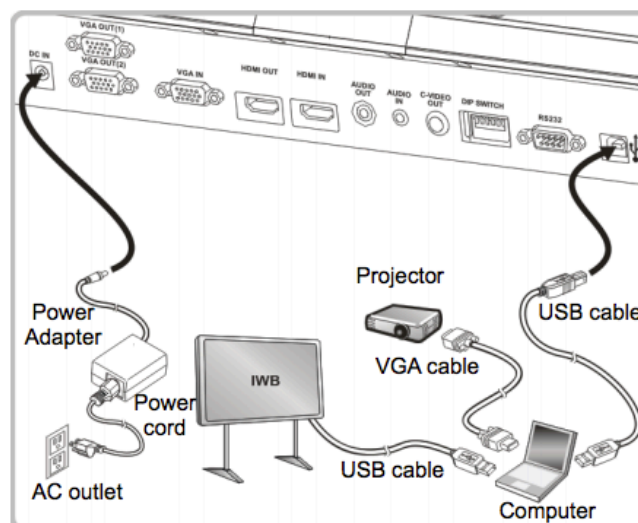
The visualiser is intended for use by clients who wish to use it for creating recorded course materials.

- The visualiser is not for use in common-use teaching spaces
- This device should be used in a private office or in a school owned space (such as a meeting room)

If using for recording:

- it is recommended to use a computer that is powerful enough to record the screen while displaying the visualiser signal. (recent model macs have been tested successfully)
- the computer will need “ladibug” software installed.

- there is an option to record directly to SD card on the visualiser device but this is not recommended.
- the visualiser has a built in microphone.
