

Nomination for Election: Griffith Business School Promotions Committee

One academic staff member of the Group at Level D or above, on a current contract of six months or more and employed at 50% or above, who is elected by the academic staff members of the Group on the same electoral roll.

Term of Office: date of election to 31/12/25

Staff wishing to stand for nomination must be:

1. listed on the Griffith Business School academic staff electoral roll* and
2. nominated by two persons on the same electoral roll.

* The electoral roll consists of the academic staff who are on current contracts of six months or more and who are employed at 50% or above.

Candidate's statement

The candidate may provide a factual statement of up to an absolute maximum of 100 words relating to their experience or other qualifications for office (any words over the 100-word limit will not be published). If this statement is in a form acceptable to the Returning Officer, it shall be published on the voting web site where it will be viewed by voters. A candidate is not obliged to provide a statement, but it should be noted that absence of a statement from one candidate will not affect the publication of acceptable statements from other candidates.
