Set up G Drive on your Android device

## Introduction

This guide will show you how to set-up the Griffith University Group drive (G drive) on your Android device. The connecting software required to enable this process is [ES File Explorer](#). It is a free application compatible with Android 2.1-2.3, 3.1, 3.2, and 4.0-4.2.

While storage access has been designed to provide support for as many platforms and devices as possible, the University **does not provide technical support for any Android device** beyond this guide.

## Step 1: Download ES File Explorer

- 1 Follow [this link](#) and download the ES File Explorer app.


Note: Your device may alert about downloading APK file.



## Step 2: Connect to the G Drive

- 1 Open ES File Explorer. Select the top left icon to access the menu.

- 2 Select LAN to access the option page.



3 Select **New** to add a new server.

4 For the following fields enter the corresponding details:

**Domain:** staff.ad.griffith.edu.au

**Server:** na-rep-cifs.staff.ad.griffith.edu.au/group  
(for Nathan, Logan, Mt Gravatt and South Bank campuses)

OR gc-staff-groups.staff.ad.griffith.edu.au/group  
(for Gold Coast campus)

**Username:** Your s number

**Password:** Your Griffith portal password

**Display as:** Griffith G drive

Select **OK** when completed.

5 Select **Griffith G Drive**.

6 The app will now present a list of your authorised G drive folders. Please note the screen capture is an example only.
